- Apprentices/trainees can only be awarded an Outward Bound Scholarship once during their training.
- Applications must be received by 5:00 pm Wednesday 10 April 2024.
- Applicants must be registered in a current training agreement in any BCITO trade excluding Carpentry.
- Accepted participants must complete a medical clearance through a GP as part of the Outward Bound enrollment process.
- Accepted participants must be fit enough to run 3.2km in under 25 minutes and be able to complete a full day of activities.*
- Applicants must have employer confirmation that paid leave (over and above the applicant's annual entitlement) will be granted for the duration of the programme 3 - 18 July 2024 = 12 working days leave required).
- Short-listed applicants may be required to be part of a pre-selection telephone interview.
- The awarded Outward Bound course is not transferable (to another person) and the offer is valid only for the Outward Bound construction watch during July of 2024.
- By submitting an application, the applicant has accepted the terms and conditions of the Outward Bound programme.
- The applicant agrees that the selection panel may contact your local BCITO representative, the workplace assessor and your employer to confirm details of your application.
- Both the participant and the employer agree to provide post-course feedback to BCITO.
